We are adding to our periodic Newsletter advice to share with our Attendees from our advisors. For April, from Dan Lund, [daniel.lund@phelps.com](mailto:daniel.lund@phelps.com), a regular of our Mock Trial presentations. Dan is a 36+ year attorney at Phelps Dunbar, practicing in construction law and complex litigation, and serving as both an arbitrator and mediator. Dan represents clients in a variety of construction-related matters, from contract negotiation and drafting through the conclusion of a project, including, as required, project claims. For the years 2023-2025, Dan has been acknowledged by Super Lawyers as a top 50 attorney in Louisiana across all practices in the state. Here, Dan will share advice to our project planner / schedulers, who I often call the "consigliore" of the superintendent of contractor or resident engineer of the owner. And perhaps then to suggest to these folks (often attendees of CCC) to offer to implement on behalf of their boss, such as to develop and share to the forepersons that weekly (or daily) safety reminder. If Ron Winter may suggest that it is the job of the site planner scheduler to address jobsite photography, as well as logging in correspondence, then also FRED suggests our Attendees support many other non-decision-making tasks which eat part of the superintendent's or resident engineer's day.

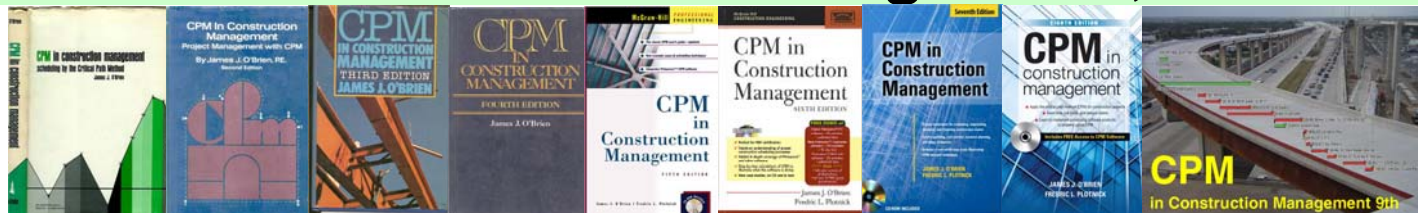
Construction superintendents are at the forefront of ensuring that projects comply with myriad federal, state, and local laws. And so, it often falls to their primary assistants, we planner/schedulers, to provide and backdrop the superintendent of the contractor or resident engineer of the owner, each busy with other tasks. While it might seem self-evident that all projects must adhere to these laws, the complex nature of regulations can make compliance challenging. These laws can range from worker's compensation and wage regulations to nondiscrimination and licensing requirements, each carrying its own set of obligations and penalties for noncompliance.
